

When you see the answer it shows a picture of a couple people using the tools to do their job.For example, the first pages say:"To build a HOUSE, start down low.[on a sign] WHOSE TOOLS ARE THOSE? Do you know?"[and on the opposite spread there is a cute picture of a chalk line, chisel, jointer, float]Then you open the right page from the middle open to the left and it shows a spread that says:[on a sign] "the MASON'S!"and the mason is saying "I smooth the cement until it's flat!"So the tools and occupations included in this book are:1. chalk line, chisel, jointer, float --> mason2. hammer, level, square, saw --> carpenter3. utility knife, snips, nail gun, ladder --> roofer4. screwdriver, drill, linesman pliers, wire stripper --> electrician5. adjustable wrench, pipe wrench, pipe cutter, pipe tape --> plumber6.
