

Edith Nesbit paraphrased Shakespeare for kids quite a long time ago, but she's still more interesting to read than Lamb's Tales of Shakespeare. The pictures here are all old illustrations of Shakespeare's stories from various illustrators, which makes some of them better than others. As a librarian I would definitely want this for my library, but I also know that it will appeal to a very rare student. There have been many versions published in the past few years which will be more accessible, notably ones by Adam McKeown. Still, this is a beautiful volume that feels so satisfying to open! Green Tiger Press (part of The Laughing Elephant) specializes in pairing vintage illustrations with great books.
