

One day when the Maestro gave everyone a math problem to work through he solved it in two seconds instead of the required ten minutes. He was crazy about numbers and loved to count. Even at home there was something to count, a pastime that made him happy. He counted the seeds in apples and pomegranates, he counted cucumber slices, grapes, peas in a pod . . . there wasn't much that would escape his eye

when it came to counting. Everyone else in school would work on their problems, but Leonardo got bored waiting for them to finish. He daydreamed away and before you know it the Maestro became angry and roared at him "You're nothing but an absent-minded, lazy dreamer, you, you BLOCKHEAD!" Well, the name stuck and every kid in town laughed at him and called him a blockhead. Leonardo saw numbers everywhere and nothing made him happier than thinking about them, but if he had to become a merchant at his father's command how could he study them? He wanted to be happy, to be free to explore numbers, but how could anyone take a boy named Blockhead seriously? This biographical look at Leonardo Fibonacci, a lover of numbers and big BLOCKHEAD is totally mesmerizing. Of course those who have a great disdain for numbers may not be very interested in this book, but just might want to take another look at them after reading about Blockhead. Fibonacci is best known for his "famous rabbit problem," the Fibonacci Sequence, which is laid out very nicely in these pages.
