

The trouble is the text, every page rhymes -- except for one -- it's like stubbing your toe in the book each time you read it. At first it made me laugh, then it started to annoy me when I read the book again and again to my daughter, as it disrupts the soothing rhythm found in most bedtime books. Why one page doesn't rhyme I don't know, but sadly it lessens my enjoyment of this book.
