

The graphic novel is laden with disà Â-honor and misà Â-ery as is the hisà Â-tory of Chià Â-nese immià Â-graà Â-tion to North Amerà Â-ica. The Chià Â-nese encounà Â-tered lynches, subà Â-juà Â-gaà Â-tion racial, culà Â-tural and legal disà Â-crimà Â-ià Â-naà Â-tion from both countries. I do rememà Â-ber learnà Â-ing in school

(but mainly on my own) about Chià Â-nese railà Â-road workà Â-ers in the United States. I did

The graphic novel shows very clearly how badly these workĂ Â-ers were misĂ Â-treated as well as their ancesĂ Â-tors who stuck around either unable or unwillĂ Â-ing to go back to China. This graphic novel is an excelĂ Â-lent introĂ Â-ducĂ Â-tion to the comĂ Â-plex issue of ChiĂ Â-nese immiĂ Â-graĂ Â-tion and is told from the ChiĂ Â-nese point of view.
