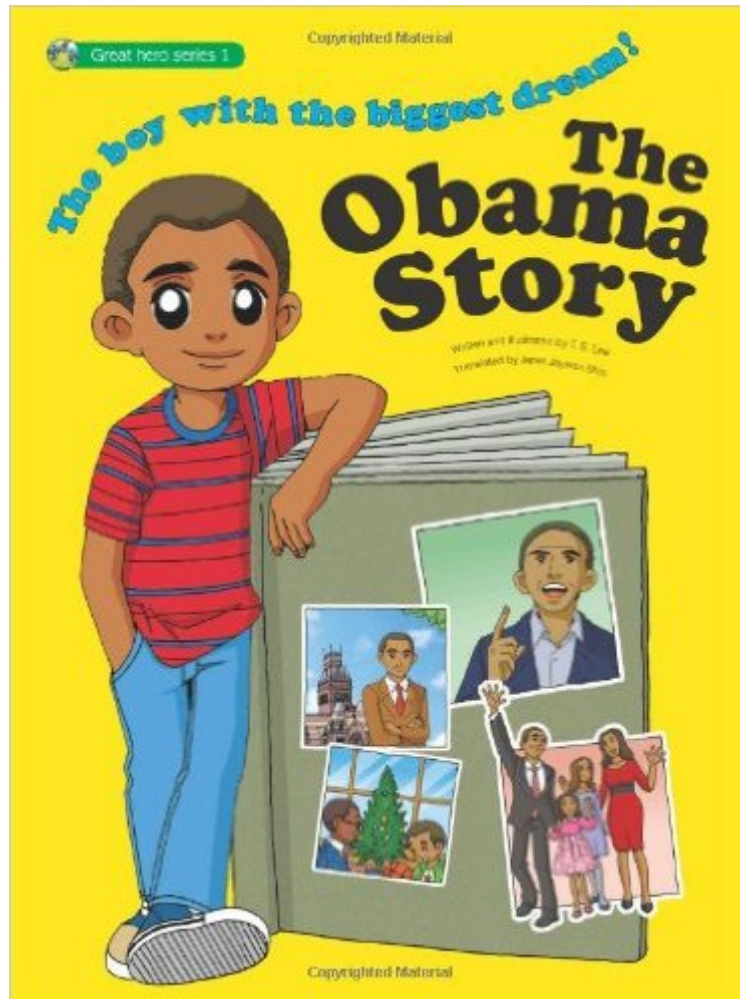

I know that this is for children, but at many points in the book Obama is portrayed as some saintly figure. I believe that biographies should contain "warts & all", even if they are for younger readers.Even so, this book is still something fun to give to the kiddies for a fun & educational read. For american manga, the artwork is pretty good & little Obama is just adorable!

My son loves to read comics. However, I was always worried about his reading choices being educational. When I found this book, I knew it would be a book my son and I would enjoy together. Cartoons can easily be weak in story, but this book is rich in content. My son loves to read because it is fun. He was impressed by President Obama's will to dream.
