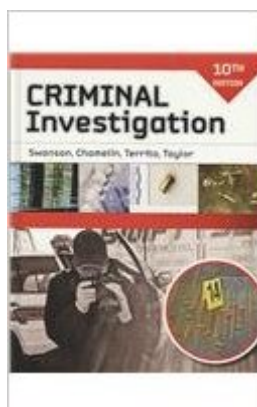

This book is by far one of the best of the criminal justice books that I have ever read.
