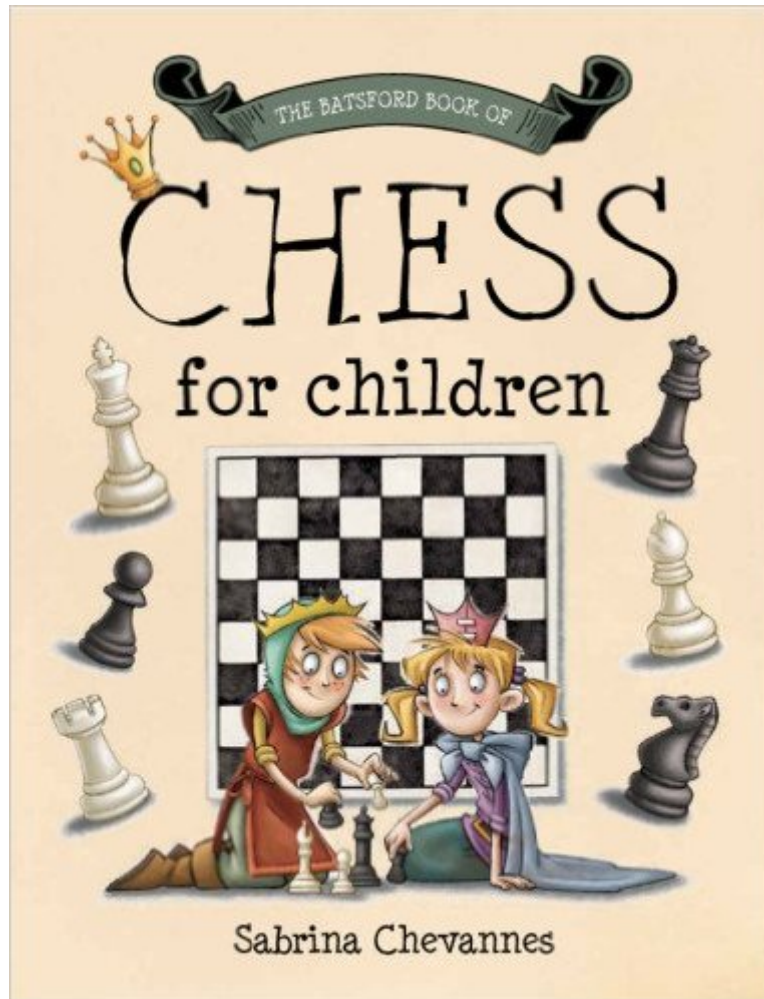

In this book, Jess and Jamie discuss chess including its history, the way the pieces move, the rules and various tactics. They cover all the basics. This is a great book to read with your child . . . you read one part while the child reads the other.

It's particularly fun for a parent and child because the book is written as a dialogue between two people (so my daughter and I trade off reading it).
