

When his father recognizes that his son will not thrive in a traditional school, he helps Ansel educate himself with access to books and also studying nature.This choice will change the path of young Ansel's life in Antsy Ansel: Ansel Adams, A Life in Nature (2016) by Cindy Jenson-Elliot, illustrated by Christy Hale.This non-fiction picture book introduces young readers to an iconic American photographer and his work documenting the country's National Parks. Jenson-Elliot's text is long enough to be informative but brief enough to remain approachable for younger readers. The biographical book also includes some little known facts about Adams such as his accomplishments as a pianist (and his subsequent choice between pursuing a career as a professional pianist or as a photography). The back matter in the book has additional details, resources, and some reprints of Adams' actual photos. Large page spreads work to bring natural wonders to life in this vibrantly colored picture book. Hale makes "antsy Ansel" immediately fascinating along with the stunning pieces of nature that captivate Adams for much of his life and career. Detailed illustrations also reproduce some of the photographer's iconic photos throughout the book. Antsy Ansel is a beautifully illustrated introduction to one of the foremost photographers in the United States. A great choice for anyone looking to introduce young readers to biographic texts and a timely read for the centennial of the National Parks System.
